2026 ZIA PARK ELIGIBILITY & SCREENING RULES

QUARTER HORSES & THOROUGHBREDS

1. Any horse that has started for a claiming /maiden claiming price of less than \$5,000 must have finished first, second or third for \$5,000 or higher since last starting for less than \$5,000. Minimum claiming price is \$7,500 (subject to change.) All Horses granted stabling should be prepared to enter and race by October 31, 2026.
2. Only unraced maidens four (4) years old or under, or maidens five (5) years of age or younger which have started, shall be permitted to start. Minimum Maiden claiming price is \$7,500 (subject to change.) Stabling preference to maidens four (4) years old and younger and for horses prepared to enter and race by October 31, 2026.
3. The following horses will be subject to additional requirements prior to being allocated stalls, permitted to train or enter, including certification of racing fitness by the trainer and attending veterinarian and/or review by Zia Park, Commission and/or Authority veterinarians: a) Horses aged 10 years or older, b) Horses with two (2) or more Shockwave or Intra-Articular injection treatments within 90 days of a race date or a total of four (4) or more within 360 days of a race date, c) five (5) year olds and older that have not raced a total of five (5) or more times in 2025/2026 and d) Quarter Horses that have not raced within 150 days of a race date.
4. Horses that have not started since July 31st, 2025, shall not be allotted stalls or permitted to train/race. Thoroughbreds that have not raced in the last 150 days must complete HISA requirements in order to be eligible to enter.
5. Any horse placed on the poor performance list, the vet's list or is vanned off in a race during the meet or in their last start at any track maybe made ineligible to start/train at the meet. Horses which have been beaten by 12 or more lengths in each of their last five (5) consecutive races shall be deemed uncompetitive unless approved by the Racing Secretary. At the discretion of the Racing Secretary, horses beaten 25 lengths or more in their prior start will be reviewed for poor performance and may be refused further entry during the race meet.
6. Zia Park reserves the right to require prior approval by the Racing Secretary of any horse prior to entry and may refuse the entry of any horse, for any reason.
7. Horses may not be approved for stabling or racing that have had trainer transfers from individuals not permitted to race at Zia Park, or under suspension (or appeal of suspension) unless approved by the Racing Secretary or Zia Park. ANY trainer transfer done within ninety (90) days prior to the start of the meet is subject to review and approval by the Racing Secretary or Zia Park. Proper documentation for claimed or privately sold horses may be required for this section. Any transfer of papers from one Trainer's file to another will result in a new entry date being established with the transfer. Horses in a trainers file at another racetrack within ninety (90) days prior to the start of the meet shall be considered under the control of that trainer. All transfers are subject to approval by the Stewards AND Zia Park.

TRAINERS MUST SUBMIT A RACING APPLICATION EVEN IF NOT PLANNING TO STABLE ON THE GROUNDS. ZERO DATES WILL NOT BE ISSUED UNTIL A RACING/STALL APPLICATION IS SUBMITTED, AND APPROVED, BY ZIA PARK.

Applications received after the due date (August 8, 2026) will receive lowest priority. Applications reviewed in order they are received. Do not enter or ship if you have not submitted an application and received notification of acceptance.

ELIGIBILITY DOES NOT MEAN APPROVAL TO RACE. FINAL DECISIONS ON ELIGIBILITY ARE AT THE SOLE DISCRETION OF ZIA PARK. Total earnings as determined by information provided by the Equibase Company shall be the determining factors in establishing eligibility. Past Performance lines and copy of trainer's current New Mexico Racing Commission license must accompany all stall/racing applications, **NO EXCEPTIONS.**

In granting stalls consideration will be given to stables with balanced stables. Zia Park reserves the right to approve all horses and the allocation of stalls at their sole discretion at any time during the meet.

Trainers are required to apply for Pony stalls. Pony stalls are not allocated for stables of less than ten (10) horses. Trainers must also apply for walker spaces which shall be allocated at the discretion of Zia Park.

If a trainer has not bedded assigned stalls or made arrangements with the Racing Secretary to show intent of occupying stalls by the first day of live racing such stalls may be reassigned.

The race office is open 7:30 a.m. to 12 noon Wednesdays (if no draw).

Racing Office will be closed on Thursdays and Fridays (if no draw).

Announcements will be made to any changes to draw schedules

Scratch time will be 10:00 a.m. the day before the race day.

PREFERENCE DATES:

1) Horses will not be eligible to receive a date, nor will registration certificates be accepted, if there is not a current negative Coggins and Piroplosmosis (For QH) attached to the registration certificate, and the horse has not been tattooed or microchipped. No AQHA Registration Certificates will be accepted at Zia Park Racing Office with more than one (1) transfer of ownership.

2) All registration certificates received on or prior to October 19, 2026, at 4:00 PM will receive a "0" date which is the lowest possible date. A horse keeps the "0" date until it runs or scratches. **No horse will be assigned a "0" date unless the stall/racing application for the trainer and horse has been approved in advance by Zia Park.**

3) All horses registering after 4:00 p.m. on October 19, 2026, will receive an "E" date corresponding to the race day that the papers/registrations are submitted to the Racing Office.

4) Horses that run will receive a running "R" date of the same day and lose any date previously held (excluding Trials, Finals and Stakes.)

5) Any horse which scratches off the program will receive a scratch "S" date and lose any date previously held. Horses placed on the Veterinarian's list or Steward's list will receive a scratch "S" date corresponding to the day they come off the list.

6) Entry "E" dates will have preference over a running "R" date of the same date. Entry "E" dates and running "R" dates will have preference over scratch "S" dates of the same date.

7) Once a horse runs, it will keep that date and lose any date previously held.

8) Horses which have established a date at the current meeting will lose that preference date should they race elsewhere and will receive a date when their papers are received back in the office.

9) In no way does claiming of a horse affect its preference date.

10) Registration certificates removed from the racing office by the owner or trainer will cause a horse to lose its date, unless for good cause (correction, breeder's stamp, etc.)

11) Trainers are not allowed to enter no more than two (2) horses in a single overnight race or three (3) horses in a single Thoroughbred overnight race without the approval of the Racing Secretary. If a trainer is allowed two entries in a single race, the horse with the best date must be preferred. If a trainer is allowed to enter three (3) horses in a single race, a third part entry cannot exclude a second part entry or a single interest, regardless of preference date. A second-part entry cannot exclude a single interest, regardless of preference date. Entries will only be accepted with the express purpose of racing in the race entered.

SEE SCRATCH RULES BELOW.

12) Horses "in-today" may not be entered in another race. This is subject to change at the Racing Secretary's discretion based on scratch patterns.

13) A horse appearing in the entries and is entered back will have no consideration should the race overfill.

14) Date preference will not supersede condition eligibility preference. Winners are preferred in all non-winners of two Allowance races (NW2.)

15) Any transfer of papers from one Trainer's file to another will result in a new entry date being established with the transfer. Transfers must be approved by the Stewards AND Zia Park.

16) In all matters, the NMRC Steward's and/or HISA Steward's ruling is final.

17) *"Registration Certificates" as used in this condition book shall mean both paper certificates and digital certificates.*

18) **Please Note** Any Thoroughbred Racehorse wishing to enter a race or conduct a timed workout at Zia Park, must be registered with HISA ("Horseracing Integrity and Safety Authority") as well as the horse's owner(s) and trainer.

IMPORTANT NOTICE: Thoroughbred Races conducted at Zia Park will be subject to all applicable HISA rules and regulations in effect at that time. Participants are encouraged to familiarize themselves with their individual responsibilities under HISA.

TRPB DIGITAL TATTOOS

Effective January 2020, any Thoroughbred making its first lifetime start requires a Digital Tattoo™.

Sign up for tattooing at Zia Park race office, and list the horse's name, barn number, your name and cell phone number. A Digital Tattoo™ is required for any horse that is planning to make their first lifetime start at Zia Park.

AQHA MICROCHIP REQUIREMENTS

As of January 1, 2024 microchips shall be required of all American Quarter Horse racehorses. Any horse tattooed before January 1, 2024 shall be permitted to have its tattoo used as a means of identification. Any two-year-old entering the Zia Park barn area, conducting an official workout of entering a race must be microchipped. For more information go to <https://www.aqha.com/microchipping-faqs>.

PLEASE NOTE: Non-tattooed or non-microchipped registration certificates will not be accepted, and trainers are advised to contact the tattoo/microchip representative for the dates and times for tattooing/microchip services.

SCRATCH RULES: Scratch time will be 10:00 a.m. the day before the race day.

All Scratches must be approved by the Stewards. If a scratch card is deposited for a horse listed as also eligible and that horse is offered an opportunity to run by at scratch time, the horse shall lose its position on the preferred list. No horse will be allowed to scratch below the minimum of eight (8) horses, unless verified by a veterinarian's certificate of unfitness or other cause acceptable by the Stewards. Excessive scratching of horses, as determined by Zia Park, may result in sanctions up to and including refusal of future entries or loss of some or all stall privileges.

Horses in stakes, handicaps and trials must scratch no later than 45 minutes prior to post-time. In all overnight races and stakes that are restricted to fewer than twelve (12) starters, up to two (2) also-eligible horses will be drawn in order of preference as the final two post positions. ***Entry of any horse which has been scratched, or excused from starting by the stewards, because of a physical disability or sickness may not be accepted until the expiration of seven (7) calendar days after such horse was scratched or excused and the horse has been removed from the veterinarian's list. Zia Park may alter this provision at its discretion.***

****PLEASE NOTE: Owner/Trainers with two (2) or more horses in an overnight race in which one of the horses is scratched – for any reason – shall not be permitted to start that horse again until the expiration of twenty-one (21) calendar days after such horse was scratched unless approved by the Racing Secretary.****

PROCEDURES FOR SCRATCHING HORSES NOT STABLED ON GROUNDS

- 1) Verification in writing from a veterinarian that he/she has treated or attended to the horse will be required before the horse will be scratched. The horse will automatically go on the Track Vet List.
- 2) To be taken off the Vet's List, the horse must be re-examined by the attending veterinarian with written recommendation to the Authority or Track Veterinarian of when the horse will be able to race.
- 3) The Authority or Track Veterinarian may have additional requirements prior to removal from the Vet List. The horse will remain on the list pending completion of these requirements. Failure to comply may result in a penalty by the stewards.

NAMING OF RIDERS

- 1) All horses must have a rider named by the time of the draw.
- 2) An apprentice allowance may only be claimed before entries have closed.
- 3) It is the trainer's responsibility to engage and name a jockey before the draw of the race. Should a rider remain unnamed at the time of the drawing of entries, the Stewards or their appointee shall select one. Once named, the stewards shall not change a rider, except for good cause.

OPTIONAL CLAIMING/ALLOWANCE

- 1) A horse when entering an Optional Claiming/Allowance has the option of being entered for the allowance conditions stated (if eligible) or the claiming price listed in the conditions.
- 2) A winner of an Optional Claiming/Allowance if entered for a claiming price shall be considered a winner of a claiming race.
- 3) A winner of an Optional Claiming/Allowance race if entered for the allowance conditions (not to be claimed) shall be considered a winner of an allowance race.

870-YARD RACES

- 1) Races conducted at 870-yards shall be considered "mixed" (open to Thoroughbred and Quarter Horses), but entry preference will be for Quarter Horses unless otherwise noted.

CONDITION ELIGIBILITY

- 1) In all lifetime condition races winners are preferred over preference dates.
- 2) Date preference will not supersede condition eligibility preference.
- 3) Any horses with three (3) or more wins are considered "multiple winners." In all races where multiple winners are preferred, all horses with three (3) or more wins are equal in preference with next preference by dates unless stated otherwise in the conditions of the race.
- 4) In all open races, including Starter Allowances and dated Allowances, multiple winners will be preferred over horses with condition eligibility (i.e. NW2, NW3) with exception to earnings preferred when specified in the conditions of the race.

****NOTE:** Any Thoroughbred which has not started in the past 365 days or any horses who have not made a start prior to January 1 of their four-year-old year shall be placed on the Veterinarian's List (HISA Rule 2240) and must perform a Workout under the supervision of the regulatory Veterinarian or his/her designee. The Horse must demonstrate to the satisfaction of the Regulatory Veterinarian this it is sound to race (HISA Rule 2242.)

HEEL NERVED HORSES: All heel-nerved horses must be reported to the Racing Secretary by the trainer when registered for racing. After registration, approval by the Track Veterinarian is required.

MANDATORY SAFETY HELMETS: All exercise riders, jockeys, trainers, outriders, pony persons, and others on horseback as well as assistant starters will be required to wear a properly fastened, Commission approved, safety helmet. The approved helmet must comply with one of the following standards of the American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM 1163); European Standards (EN-1384, PAS-015 or VG1); or Australian/New Zealand Standard (AS/NZ 3838 or ARB HS 2012) while on or proceeding to or from the racetrack. **No Caliente Helmets Allowed. NO HELMET SHALL BE ALTERED IN ANY MANNER NOR SHALL THE PRODUCT MARKING BE REMOVED OR DEFACED.**

MANDATORY SAFETY VESTS (NMAC 15.2.5.13(8)): All exercise riders, jockeys, trainers, outriders, pony persons, and others on horseback as well as assistant starters will be required to wear a properly fastened, Commission approved, safety vest. The approved safety vest must comply with one of the following standards: British Equestrian Trade Association (BETA) 2000 level 1: or, Euro Norm (EN) 13158:2000 Level 1; or, American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) F1781-08 or F1937; or Shoe and Allied Trade Research association (SATRA) Jockey Vest Document M6 Issue 3; or, Australian Racing Board (ARB) Standard 1, 1998. **NO VEST SHALL BE ALTERED IN ANY MANNER NOR SHALL THE PRODUCT MARKING BE REMOVED OR DEFACED.** Jockeys and Exercise Riders shall have securely attached to his/her safety vest one or more medical information cards describing his/her medical history and any conditions pertinent to emergency care, including listing of any previous injuries, drug allergies and current medications (HISA Rules 2292(a))

SHOEING POLICY: Shoeing for Thoroughbred racehorses racing or training at Zia Park must conform with HISA requirements (HISA Rule 2276). As of the date of publication Thoroughbreds shall be permitted to be shod on the hindlimbs with traction devices in the form of a full outer rim shoe (up to 4 mm in height) or a toe grab (up to 4 mm in height). Traction devices shall not be permitted on forelimbs of Thoroughbreds. Traction devices include, but are not limited to rims, toe grabs, bends, jar caulks and stickers.

REINS (NMAC 15.2.5.13(3)): No jockey, apprentice jockey, exercise person or any person mounted on a horse shall ride, breeze, exercise, gallop or workout a horse on the grounds of a facility under the jurisdiction of the commission unless the horse is equipped with a nylon rein or a safety rein. A safety rein is a rein with a wire or nylon cord stitched into the traditional leather rein during the manufacturing process and the safety cord is attached to the bit with a metal clasp.

CLAIMING RULE: A claimed horse shall not race elsewhere, except within the state, or out of state stakes races, for a period of thirty (30) days or the end of the meet, whichever occurs first. If a horse is claimed, it shall not be sold or transferred wholly or in part, except in a claiming race for a period of thirty (30) days from the date of the claim, nor shall it, unless reclaimed, remain in the same stable under the control or management of its former owner or trainer for a like period. Once a horse is claimed it may race back for any claiming price.

TRANSFER OF CLAIMED HORSE RECORDS (HISA Rule 2261) For Thoroughbreds Only (a) Entry of Horses subject to being claimed in a Claiming Race implies Owner (Trainer as the agent of the Owner) consent for transfer of all Trainer and veterinary examination and treatment records for the last sixty (60) days to the new Trainer of the claimed Horse; (b) If a Horse is successfully claimed by a new Trainer, the previous Trainer must transfer Trainer records and authorize transfer of veterinary records to the new Trainer within three (3) days of transfer of the Horse to the new Trainer. Transfer of Trainer records include only records of medical, therapeutic and surgical treatments and procedures. Required records do not include other materials relating to training techniques or protocols.

VOID CLAIM (HISA Rule 2262) For Thoroughbreds Only (a) Except as provided in paragraphs (e) and (g), title to a Covered Horse which is claimed shall be vested in the successful claimant from the time the field has been dispatched from the starting gate and the Covered Horse becomes a starter. (b) All claimed Covered Horses shall go to the Test Barn, or, if approved by the Authority, the secured area used for claimed Covered Horse inspections, for observation by the Regulatory Veterinarian. (c) Test Barn or approved secured area observation: (1) upon entry into the Test Barn or approved secured area, a claimed Covered Horse shall be periodically observed for no less than 30 minutes during the "cooling out" process, unless excused by the Regulatory Veterinarian. (2) a claimed Covered Horse shall be observed by the Regulatory Veterinarian at the completion of any required sample collection, or immediately before the Covered Horse is released from the Test Barn or approved secured area, to determine whether the claimed Covered Horse will be placed on the Veterinarians' List for Epistaxis, or as unsound or lame. (3) the minimum criteria for observation by the Regulatory Veterinarian are: (i) to assess the claimed Covered Horse for signs of Epistaxis or any other concerning clinical abnormalities; and (ii) to jog the claimed Covered Horse in hand in a straight line of not fewer than 5 strides moving toward and away from the Regulatory Veterinarian. (d) If a claimed Covered Horse is placed on the Veterinarians' List for Epistaxis, or as unsound or lame, it is the responsibility of the Regulatory Veterinarian to notify the Stewards immediately so that the Stewards may order the Claim voided. (e) The Claim shall be voided, and ownership of the Covered Horse retained by the original Owner, if: (1) the Covered Horse dies or is euthanized before the Covered Horse is released to the claimant; (2) the Covered Horse is vanned off of the racing track and placed on the Veterinarians' List for Epistaxis, or as unsound or lame; or (3) the Regulatory Veterinarian determines pursuant to the observation described in Rule 2262(c)(1) that the Covered Horse will be placed on the Veterinarians' List for Epistaxis, or as unsound or lame before the Covered Horse is released to the successful claimant. (f) The Claim shall not be voided if, prior to the Race in which the Covered Horse is claimed, the claimant elects to claim the Covered Horse by checking the appropriate box on the claim slip regardless of whether the Regulatory Veterinarian determines the Covered Horse will be

placed on the Veterinarians' List for Epistaxis or as unsound or lame. (g) Notwithstanding Rule 3060(a) and 3070(c), and subject to Rule 2262(h), if a postrace sample collected from a claimed Covered Horse on the day of the Claim results in an Adverse Analytical Finding, the claimant shall be promptly notified by the Agency or the Authority and the claimant shall have the option to void the claim. The claimant shall have 48 hours from notification of the Adverse Analytical Finding to void the claim by submitting in writing to the Stewards the claimant's decision to void the claim. If the claimant chooses to void the Claim: (1) the claimant shall be entitled to the return from the prior Owner of all sums paid for the claimed Covered Horse; (2) the claimant shall be entitled, upon submission of expense records, to recoup reasonable expenses from the prior Owner related to the care, custody and control of the Covered Horse incurred after the date of the claim; and (3) the claimed Covered Horse shall be returned to the prior Owner. (h) A claimant shall not have the option to void a Claim pursuant to Rule 2262(g) if any of the following events have occurred since the Claim: (1) the claimed Covered Horse has made a start in a Covered Horserace or race; (2) the claimant failed to exercise due care in maintaining and boarding the claimed Covered Horse; (3) the claimant made material alterations to the claimed Covered Horse; or (4) the claimed Covered Horse dies or is euthanized.

WAIVER CLAIMING OPTION (HISA Rule 2263) For Thoroughbreds

Only (a) At time of entry into a Claiming Race an Owner or Responsible Person may opt to declare a Covered Horse ineligible to be claimed, provided: (1) the Covered Horse has not started in 120 days; (2) the Covered Horse's last start must have been for a claiming price; and (3) the Covered Horse is entered in a claiming race with a claiming price equal to or greater than the claiming price for which it last started. (b) A Responsible Person may opt to declare a Covered Horse ineligible to be claimed for a second consecutive race, provided: (1) the waiver must have been asserted in the first race back to be eligible for the second waiver; (2) if the Covered Horse wins the first race back, it is ineligible for the second waiver; (3) if the Covered Horse changes majority ownership subsequent to the first race, it is ineligible for the second waiver; and (4) the provisions in 2263(a)(3) still apply.

STABLE GATE/ENTRY REQUIREMENTS – IMPORTANT – PLEASE READ

All horses, including ponies, entering stable area must submit the following requirements to pass through Zia Park stable gate:

- a) **Horses stabled at, and shipping directly from, The Downs at Albuquerque must be accompanied with a health certificate issued at the point of origin within the past thirty (30) days for entry to the Zia Park backstretch. Horses stabled or shipping from ANY other location must have an ORIGINAL (Owner's Copy) of a Health Certificate issued at the point of origin within the previous five (5) days of arrival at Zia Park;**
- b) **ALL horses entering the Zia Park backstretch will be required to have a current negative Coggins test certificate within the past 365 days. Inventory lists will only be permitted for horses/trainers stabled at, and shipping directly from the Downs at Albuquerque if they include the following information: Horse Name, Microchip/Tattoo #, Date of Blood Draw and Read Dates. Horses arriving from ANY other location will be required to have**

their ORIGINAL Negative Coggins paperwork when arriving at the stable gate or on file with the Racing Office in advance of arrival. NO EXCEPTIONS. A negative Coggins certificate must be on file with all horse papers prior to the papers being submitted to the Racing Office.

- c) ALL Quarter Horses and Ponies entering the Zia Park backstretch will be required to have a current negative Piroplasmosis (Babesia equi) test within the past twelve (12) months. Inventory lists will be permitted if they include the same information as Coggins paperwork above. Horses arriving from ANY location will be required to have their ORIGINAL Negative Piroplasmosis paperwork when arriving at the stable gate or on file with the Racing Office in advance of arrival. Equine Piroplasmosis is a reportable disease and horses testing positive for this disease in New Mexico must be immediately quarantined. In addition, Stallions require an NMLB entry permit number.
- d) Horsemen should ensure horses are not exposed to the New World Screwworm and take proper precautions. See www.screwworm.gov for updated information.

In addition to the requirements above, pursuant to the Commission's "Contagious Equine Disease Protocols" effective May 11, 2017, and HISA minimum requirements, all horses entering the Zia Park stable area must additionally present the following:

- 1) Verification of Influenza and Rhinopneumonitis vaccinations within the past six (6) months, and; verification of Eastern and Western Equine Encephalitis, Tetanus, Rabies and West Nile vaccinations within the last twelve (12) months. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** Requirements for entry to stable area are subject to change at any time. In the event of an outbreak of a contagious disease within the state, a health certificate for ALL horses entering the grounds of Zia Park must have been issued within 72 hours of arrival.

All "Work and Go" horses must have approval from Racing Secretary, Racing Manager or Stall Superintendent in advance before arriving on the grounds. A horse's Trainer and/or Assistant Trainer must be present with the horse to work. Horses arriving with owners will not be allowed on the track. Appointments must be made a minimum of 48 hours prior to work.

No horse that is stabled on the grounds and is entered to race, or a Race and Go that has arrived on the grounds, shall be permitted to leave the grounds until its race has been conducted, unless prior approval by the Racing Secretary or Racing Manager. In the event of an emergency situation the Racing Secretary or Racing Manager should be notified immediately.

Please note that access through the stable gate may be limited to certain times during the overnight hours.

GENERAL RULES AND INFORMATION:

- 1) Any horse, in a race, may not be sold or transferred until that obligation is completed, except with permission of the Stewards. Trainer transfers from individuals not permitted to race at Zia Park shall not be permitted within seventy-five (75) days prior to the start of the meet unless approved by the Racing Secretary or Zia Park. All trainer transfers, even if approved by the Commission, are subject to review and approval by the Racing Secretary or Zia Park.
- 2) The Racing Secretary may refuse any entry, for any reason.
- 3) Trainers are advised that horses which are claimed and are back in on another race day may be required to fulfill that engagement despite the change of ownership. A horse's engagements shall follow the horse.
- 4) Zia Park shall have the right to declare off any advertised stake or feature race that fails to have a minimum of seven (7) separate betting interests entered. In such cases, all fees paid will be refunded.
- 5) The Stewards, Track, State or Authority Veterinarian, Racing Manager or Racing Secretary shall have the right to bar from racing, or exclude from the grounds, any horse which they deem unsafe, unsound or any horse deemed to be uncompetitive.
- 6) Owners, Trainers and/or their agents are responsible for their horses' eligibility, must claim all weight allowances at time of entry. While the racing office will make every effort to ensure preferences are given, it is the owner, trainer or their agent's responsibility to declare any preference at time of entry. The Racing Secretary will provide any information requested, but the final responsibility rests strictly with the Owner and Trainer.
- 7) The Racing Secretary shall have the right to choose from each day's entries the races that allow for the best card for the public.
- 8) Certain races may be kept open or changed after 10:00 AM at the Racing Secretary's discretion.
- 9) Trainers are responsible for the correct information (name of horse/destination) being properly filled out for all horses shipping in and out of the stable gate.
- 10) Trainers are required to have all employees licensed properly that work in the stable area. All individuals must present a valid New Mexico State Horse Racing Commission license for admittance to the Zia Park stable area and display the license at all times while on the grounds of Zia Park. All Thoroughbred Trainers and their employees must be registered with HISA.
- 11) Trainers are responsible for their guests at all times in the stable area. Any individual under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult at all times and only permitted in the barn area with prior approval of security. Zia Park reserves the right to amend its entrance policy at any time.
- 12) Smoking is prohibited anywhere within the confines of a barn or any horse shelter.
- 13) No dogs, fowl, or exotic animals will be permitted in the stable area or on the grounds.

- 14) Outriders are on duty every morning and are there for the protection of everyone. They will enforce all rules on the racetrack, and any foul or abusive language towards them will result in a fine and/or removal of horses from the grounds.
- 15) Any emergency sound and light system is used for emergencies on the racetrack. When system is activated riders should pull up their mounts and move to exit the racetrack at the nearest point. Failure to do so will result in a fine and/or removal of horses from the grounds.
- 16) All grooms should be clean and neatly dressed when taking horses to the paddock.
- 17) The Trainer/Owner of Horse(s) of a deceased horse on the grounds of Zia Park or by a racing/training incident shall be charged a removal/Necropsy Fee.
- 18) Vehicles in the stable area will be restricted to areas as authorized by Zia Park. Vehicles may be required to be registered with Security at the discretion of Zia Park. Parking is only permitted in areas as specified by Zia Park. Failure to adhere to parking rules may result in loss of parking privileges or vehicles being removed from premises at the expense of vehicle owner. Parking of ANY vehicles between barns is not permitted.
- 19) All race/work and go horses must go to receiving barn and stable in their assigned stalls. Please contact stall superintendent when shipping in for overnight stay or shipping in during overnight hours.
- 20) All individuals on the grounds of Zia Park or participating in races at Zia Park are subject to the Penn Entertainment, Inc./Zia Park Horsemen's Guide which can be accessed at <https://www.ziaparkcasino.com/racing>

OWNER REQUIREMENTS

- 1) All Owners are required to be licensed with the Commission, and all Thoroughbred owners must be registered with HISA prior to entering a horse.
- 2) All Owners are required to furnish the Horsemen's Bookkeeper with their mailing addresses and social security numbers and an IRS Form W-9 completely filled out. Confirming identification may be required to be presented.
- 3) Prior to entry, the owner of a horse is required to have all funds deposited with the Horsemen's Bookkeeper to cover the expense of starting that horse. No horse will be allowed to start unless this requirement is met.
- 4) Zia Park will provide colors for all owners who wish to use them. Any owner wishing to use stable colors must register them with the Racing Office prior to their use. No colors will be used which do not appear on the official program.

WORKOUT RULES (NMAC 15.2.5.11)

- 1) A non-starter must have had within 60 days prior to time of entry at least two (2) workouts recorded at a pari-mutuel or commission recognized facility and posted with the racing secretary prior to time of entry, one of the two workouts shall be from the starting gate, and be gate approved.

- 2) Any horse which has started, but not within 60 days, must have at least one official workout within 60 days prior to time of entry. Horses that have not started within six months of entry must have at least two approved workouts within the 60 days prior to entry.
- 3) Horses that have never raced around the turn will be required to have within 30 days prior to time of entry, at least one workout at 660 yards or farther.
- 4) Gate approvals at a licensed facility must be made by a licensed starter on a commission approved form.

In addition to the above, Zia Park shall require the following regarding workouts:

- All Trainers **MUST** fill out completely and accurately Workout Cards for every horse scheduled to work out and present them to the gap attendant prior to entering the track to work. Any violation of this rule is subject to denial of entry, removal of horses from grounds and subject to a fine. Workout Cards are available in the Racing Office, Stable Gate and with the Gap attendant. Work Out Cards should include trainer, horse, type of work and distance.
- A horse's registration certificate must be on file with the racing office before a horse will receive an official work.
- No horse shall work without proper notification to the clocker.
- No Thoroughbred will be permitted to receive a timed workout without being HISA registered.

PLEASE NOTE: WORKOUTS WILL ONLY BE ACCEPTED FROM RECOGNIZED RACETRACKS AND FRONTERA TRAINING CENTER. NO GATE WORKS WILL BE ACCEPTED FROM FRONTERA TRAINING CENTER.

HORSEMEN'S BOOKKEEPER

- 1) The office will open at 9:00 a.m. to 4 p.m. on race days. The Bookkeeper will be accessible via email (zia-hbk@pennentertainment.com) or phone at 575-492-7029.
- 2) All owners are required to be licensed. In order to transact business properly owners need to have their correct names, addresses, social security numbers, tax identification numbers and completed W-9 on file to receive check withdrawals.
- 3) **Please Note: deposits for claims and any other transactions with the Horsemen's Bookkeeper must be done through a cashier's check or money order. NO CASH WILL BE ACCEPTED.**

HORSEMEN'S CHECKS

- 1) Internal Revenue Service regulations require submission of a signed W-8 or W-9 form with Federal ID number or Social Security number in order for checks to be issued. Failure to file these forms will require 31% withholding of all funds. Please contact the Horsemen's Bookkeeper for further information.
- 2) **All payments from the Horsemen's Bookkeeper will be made via Direct Deposit/ACH. All accounts need to fill out the appropriate paperwork and provide the necessary information in order to receive payments. Required paperwork is available on the Zia Park website and in the Racing Office and Horsemen's Bookkeeper's office.**

SALIX (LASIX) RULES AND REQUIREMENTS: All horses on the approved Salix list must be administered Salix at least four (4) hours prior to scheduled post time. All horses receiving Salix must be logged in at the stable gate with time and location **NO LESS THAN ONE (1) HOUR PRIOR TO ADMINISTRATION.** ****Please Note: No Thoroughbred horse in a stake race or any race for 2-year-old Thoroughbreds shall be permitted to receive Lasix.****

JOCKEY MOUNT FEES

The following Jockey Mount Fees are to be paid to jockeys riding in races at all race tracks in the state of New Mexico.

The approved Jockey Mount Fee Scale shall be used in the absence of an individual contract. All parties acknowledge that jockeys are free to negotiate their own terms for each horse they ride and this approved scale does not alter or otherwise impede the Jockeys' ability to negotiate a different mount fee on an individual basis.

In the absence of a contract, jockey mount fees shall be as follows (all finishers past 6th place will receive jockey mount fee):

NEW MEXICO RACING COMMISSION - NMRC) TESTING FEE

Please Note: Pursuant NMAC 15.2.3.8 D. (4) (a) (Payment of Purses) the NMRC will institute a drug testing fee of \$20.00 per start for all horses starting in a race in New Mexico. This deduction will be made through each owner's bookkeeper account.

NEW MEXICO BRED INCENTIVE FUND

This program will permit a New Mexico Bred horse entering an open overnight race and finishing first, second or third to receive a 20% increase of the original purse. The money generated from this program will come from the gaming portion of the overnight purse fund. The money also is excluded from the 10% Breeders Awards monies.

The incentive money will be distributed as follows:

- First place will get 63% of the incentive money and the original first place purse.
- Second place will get 24% of the incentive money and the original second place purse.
- Third place will get 13% of the incentive money plus the original third place purse.

Money will be wired on a bi-weekly basis and this schedule may be adjusted if necessary. All undistributed incentive money will be carried over to the next meet, if applicable.

This program will be monitored by the New Mexico Horse Breeders Association (NMBA) and track management to ensure that this is beneficial to the New Mexico Bred Program. Reports on this program will be given at the monthly Commission meetings and any changes to the program must be approved by the Racing Commission.

REGISTERED ARIZONA BREDS RACING AT ZIA PARK

Horses bred in Arizona and registered with the NMBA are eligible to enter overnight races restricted to New Mexico bred horses. Registered Arizona breds may enter New Mexico bred restricted stake races but shall not receive preference.

Penn Entertainment, Inc. Animal Welfare Policy

The health and safety of the equine participants at all PENN racing properties is of paramount importance and all Racing Participants, especially those who are entrusted with the ownership and the ongoing care of these animals, must take all reasonable actions and care to ensure such equine participants are treated with dignity and respect.

Any Racing Participant covered by this Guide who handles or treats any animal without regard for the well-being of the animal or causes physical injury or pain or suffering to the animal, including excessive or unnecessary training/whipping, transporting (including transport by cargo ship), or neglect in the care or feeding or medical attention shown to the animal, as determined in the sole discretion of Racetrack, may be sanctioned. Except as required by statute or regulation, it is the sole responsibility of the trainer to ensure that a licensed and competent veterinarian is available at all times to ensure the health and welfare of such trainer's horses and to attend to trainer's horses at all times such horses are on the grounds of Racetrack in any and all emergency situations in which a Regulatory or Racetrack veterinarian is not required to be present or to respond to a trainer's horse(s). As a condition of entry in any race conducted at a PENN Racetrack, each trainer and his/her attending veterinarian acknowledges and represents that the horse entered to race has had the proper pre-race examinations to determine the horse is physically fit to race.

In the event Racetrack receives credible and verifiable information regarding a Racing Participant who knowingly, or without conducting proper due diligence, buys or sells a horse for slaughter, directly or indirectly, such individual(s) may be sanctioned by the Racetrack up to and including revocation of stalls and exclusion from racing at all PENN properties. The Racetrack highly encourages Racing Participants to obtain proper written documentation on sale or transfer of any horse that they previously raced or was stabled on the grounds of Racetrack and lack of such documentation shall be considered a failure in due diligence efforts. The Racetrack reserves the right to require trainer or individuals responsible for a horse to provide such documentation as requested and failure to cooperate may result in sanctions by the Racetrack, up to and including revocations of stalls and exclusion from racing at all PENN properties.

All trainers entering a horse to race at a PENN racetrack acknowledge that his/her horse is physically fit to compete in such race(s) and the trainer has taken all reasonable efforts, including an examination and clearance to race by his/her personal veterinarian, to ensure that horse shall not pose a risk to itself or any other competitor in that race. Trainers shall ensure when a horse in his/her care is racing and/or training at a PENN track that a licensed veterinarian contracted by the trainer is available at all times to respond to any medical incident or emergency for the horse. Failure to make all efforts to ensure a horse under a trainer's care is not physically fit or capable of competing shall result in revocation or racing and stabling privileges for that trainer.
